A consistent approach to pedagogy across every classroom at Belgian Gardens State School where our community has an active hand in supporting and celebrating learning.

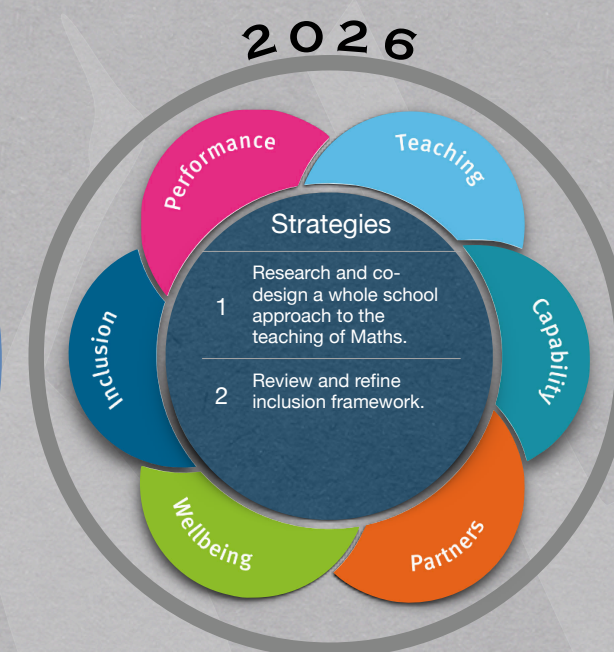
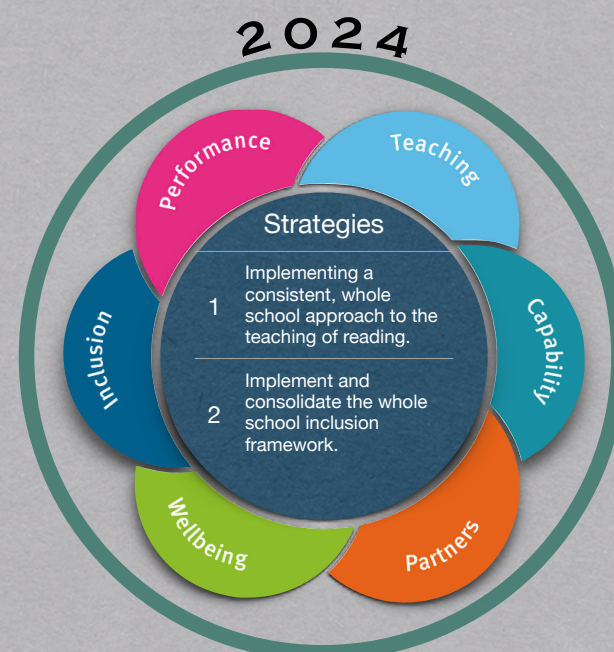
Every teacher and parent can articulate what their students/children need in order to progress their ability to read, analyse and evaluate a variety of texts.
